Identifying Songs using Siri



Have you ever been listening to a song on your radio and wondered "who is singing this?" or "what is this song called?" Well, don't worry, Siri can find out for you!

To find out the name of playing song, using Siri, follow these suggested steps:

Note 1: These instructions have been created using an iPhone 15 Pro, running iOS 26.2. If you are running a different version of iOS, you may find some minor differences. However, it isn't expected that you will!

1. Press and hold down the Wake/Sleep button on your device, or if your device has a Home Button, press and hold this down instead. Upon doing this, Siri will start listening to you and a sound will play to alert you of this.

Note 2: If you have Siri or Hey Siri enabled, you can say "Hey Siri" instead to invoke Siri.

2. Say "what's this song?". Upon doing this, Siri will say "naming this tune", or "hang on, let me listen".

3. A few seconds later, Siri will provide you with the name of the song and the artist performing it.

Note 3: If you don't get a satisfactory response from Siri, try holding your phone closer to the source of the music and try again!
